GOD/TRINITY

1. No one who denies the Son has the Father; everyone who confesses the Son has the Father also. [**1 John 2:23**]
2. Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood abide in me, and I in them. [**John 6:56**]

34. Praise the Lord! Happy are those who fear the Lord, who greatly delight in his commandments. [**Psalms 112:1**]

63. Yet if any of you suffers as a Christian, do not consider it a disgrace, but glorify God because you bear this name. [**1 Peter 4:16**]

HUMILITY

64. All who exalt themselves will be humbled, and all who humble themselves will be exalted.[**Matthew 23:12**]

65. Let us not become conceited, competing against one another, envying one another.[**Galatians 5:26**]

CHARITY

66. Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.[**Hebrews 13:16**]

FORGIVENESS

67. Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.[**Colossians 3:13**]

71. For just as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous. [**Romans 5:19**]

72. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, and in their eagerness to be rich some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pains. [**1 Timothy 6:10**]
