## GOD/TRINITY

1. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you. [ **2 Corinthians 13:13** ]
2. Indeed, just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to whomsoever he wishes. [ **John 5:21** ]
3. Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. [ **John 14:6** ]
4. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with which you were marked with a seal for the day of redemption. [ **Ephesians 4:30** ]
5. Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit that is from God, so that we may understand the gifts bestowed on us by God. [ **1 Corinthians 2:12** ]
6. The heavens are yours, the earth also is yours; the world and all that is in it—you have founded them [ **Psalms 89:11** ]

## GOD'S WORDS

7. I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you. [ **Psalms 32:8** ]
8. This God—his way is perfect; the promise of the Lord proves true; he is a shield for all who take refuge in him. [ **Psalms 18:30** ]
9. The Lord will make you the head, and not the tail; you shall be only at the top, and not at the bottom—if you obey the commandments the Lord your God, which I am commanding you today, by diligently observing them, [ **Deuteronomy 28:13** ]
10. The promises of the Lord are promises that are pure, silver refined in a furnace on the ground, purified seven times. [ **Psalms 12:6** ]
11. The time is surely coming, says the Lord God, when I will send a famine on the land; not a famine of bread, or a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord. [ **Amos 8:11** ]

## GOD'S LOVE

12. But he was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the punishment that made us whole, and by his bruises we are healed. [ **Isaiah 53:5** ]

13. 'Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. [ **John 3:17** ]
14. let the wicked forsake their way, and the unrighteous their thoughts; let them return to the Lord, that he may have mercy on them, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. [ **Isaiah 55:7** ]
15. As a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has compassion for those who fear him. [ **Psalm 103:13** ]
16. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.[ **2 corinthians 5:21** ]

## GOD'S CARE

17. Because he himself was tested by what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested. [ **Hebrews 2:18** ]
18. Look at the birds of the air; they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?[ **Matthew 6:26** ]
19. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord rescues them from them all.[ **Psalm 34:19** ]
20. The young lions suffer want and hunger, but those who seek the Lord lack no good thing.[ **Psalm 34:10** ]
21. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. [ **Proverbs 3:6** ]
22. Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight.[**Proverbs 3:5** ]
23. Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. [ **Matthew 11:28** ]
24. Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labour in vain. Unless the Lord guards the city, the guard keeps watch in vain. [ **Psalm 127:1** ]
25. The Lord, your God, is in your midst, a warrior who gives victory; he will rejoice over you with gladness, he will renew you in his love; he will exult over you with loud singing  
[ **Zephaniah 3:17** ]
26. God, the Lord, is my strength; he makes my feet like the feet of a deer, and makes me tread upon the heights.[ **Habakkuk 3:19** ]

## FAITH IN GOD

27. The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.[**Proverbs 1:7** ]

## GOD'S CALL

28. For God did not call us to impurity but in holiness.[ **1 Thessalonians 4:7** ]

## HEAVEN

29. 'Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord", will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only one who does the will of my Father in heaven.[ **Matthew 7:21** ]

## RESURRECTION

30. For the Lord himself, with a cry of command, with the archangel's call and with the sound of God's trumpet, will descend from heaven, and the dead in Christ will rise first.[ **1 Thessalonians 4:16** ]

31. Then afterward I will pour out my spirit on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions.[ **Joel 2:28** ]

## MERCY

32. But each of us was given grace according to the measure of Christ's gift.[ **Ephesians 4:7** ]

## CHURCH

33. Built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. [ **Ephesians 2:20** ]

## ETERNAL LIFE

34. because we look not at what can be seen but at what cannot be seen; for what can be seen is temporary, but what cannot be seen is eternal.[ **2 Corinthians 4:18** ]

35. If you sow to your own flesh, you will reap corruption from the flesh; but if you sow to the Spirit, you will reap eternal life from the Spirit.[ **Galatians 6:8** ]

## BLESSED

36. 'Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. [ **Matthew 5:10** ]
37. Happy are those who consider the poor; the Lord delivers them in the day of trouble.[ **Psalm 41:1** ]

## DISCIPLESHIP

38. 'I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.[ **John 10:11** ]
39. 'You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how can its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything, but is thrown out and trampled under foot. [ **Matthew 5:13** ]

## CHRISTIAN LIFE

40. May I never boast of anything except the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. [ **Galatians 6:14** ]
41. For our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. [ **Ephesians 6:12** ]
42. Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved by him, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly explaining the word of truth. [ **2 Timothy 2:15** ]
43. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, and put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation.[ **1 Thessalonians 5:8** ]

## PRAYER/WORSHIP

44. For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected, provided it is received with thanksgiving; [ **1 Timothy 4:4** ]
45. Stay awake and pray that you may not come into the time of trial; the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.' [ **Matthew 26:41** ]
46. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and do not forget all his benefits [ **Psalm 103:2** ]
47. Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in my house, and thus put me to the test, says the Lord of hosts; see if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour down for you an overflowing blessing.[ **Malachi 3:10** ]

48. Are any among you sick? They should call for the elders of the church and have them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord.[ **James 5:14** ]

## INTERCESSION / SAINTS

49. But the righteous live forever, and their reward is with the Lord; the Most High takes care of them.[ **Wisdom 5:15** ]

50. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin. [ **Hebrews 4:15** ]

51. Whoever welcomes a prophet in the name of a prophet will receive a prophet's reward; and whoever welcomes a righteous person in the name of a righteous person will receive the reward of the righteous; [ **Matthew 10:41** ]

## PARENTS, TEACHERS

52. But we appeal to you, brothers and sisters, to respect those who labour among you, and have charge of you in the Lord and admonish you; [ **1 Thessalonians 5:12** ]

## DEPARTED

53. . It is better to go to the house of mourning than to go to the house of feasting; for this is the end of everyone, and the living will lay it to heart. [ **Ecclesiastes 7:2** ]

## LIGHT

54. I have come as light into the world, so that everyone who believes in me should not remain in the darkness.[ **John 12:46** ]

## KNOWLEDGE

55. Everyone then who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock. [ **Matthew 7:24** ]

56. because wisdom will not enter a deceitful soul, or dwell in a body enslaved to sin.[ **Wisdom 1:4** ]

57. The quiet words of the wise are more to be heeded than the shouting of a ruler among fools.[ **Ecclesiastes 9:17** ]

58. A rebuke strikes deeper into a discerning person than a hundred blows into a fool [ **Proverbs 17:10** ]

## SINCERITY

59. But the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one. [ **2 Thessalonians 3:3** ]
60. 'Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. [ **Luke 16:10** ]

## FAITH

61. But if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. [ **Romans 6:8** ]
62. See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the universe, and not according to Christ.  
[ **Colossians 2:8** ]
63. Do not follow other gods, any of the gods of the peoples who are all around you, because the Lord your God, who is present with you, is a jealous God. The anger of the Lord your God would be kindled against you and he would destroy you from the face of the earth. [ **Deuteronomy 6:14** ]

## HOPE

64. My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning, more than those who watch for the morning. [ **Psalms 130:6** ]
65. For we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. [ **2 Corinthians 5:1** ]
66. From now on there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have longed for his appearing. [ **2 Timothy 4:8** ]
67. Let me abide in your tent forever, find refuge under the shelter of your wings. [ **Psalms 61:4** ]
68. 'The Lord is my portion,' says my soul, 'therefore I will hope in him.' [ **Lamentations 3:24** ]

## LOVE

69. If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels, but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. [ **1 Corinthians 13:1** ]
70. So we have known and believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them. [ **1 John 4:16** ]
71. And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love. [ **1 Corinthians 13:13** ]



72. But when you thus sin against members of your family, and wound their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ. [ **1 Corinthians 8:12** ]

73. . ‘This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. [ **John 15:12** ]

74. If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. [ **Mark 3:24** ]

## RIGHTEOUSNESS/ TRUTH

75. . Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor, and the face of God will not be turned away from you. [ **Tobit 4:8** ]

76. for the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.[ **Psalm 1:6** ]

77. You shall have only a full and honest weight; you shall have only a full and honest measure, so that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.[ **Deuteronomy 25:15** ]

78. Light dawns for the righteous, and joy for the upright in heart.[ **Psalm 97:11** ]

79. No harm happens to the righteous, but the wicked are filled with trouble. [ **Proverbs 12:21** ]

80. The father of the righteous will greatly rejoice; he who begets a wise son will be glad in him. [ **Proverbs 23:24** ]

81. Crooked minds are an abomination to the Lord, but those of blameless ways are his delight. [ **Proverbs 11:20** ]

82. The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the Lord, but the prayer of the upright is his delight. [ **Proverbs 15:8** ]

83. For nothing is hidden that will not be disclosed, nor is anything secret that will not become known and come to light. [ **Luke 8:17** ]

## SIN/REPENTANCE

84. Evil brings death to the wicked, and those who hate the righteous will be condemned.[ **Psalm 34:21** ]

85. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.[ **James 4:8** ]

## FORTITUDE

86. Endure trials for the sake of discipline. God is treating you as children; for what child is there whom a parent does not discipline? [ **Hebrews 12:7** ]

87. The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we will also live with him; [ **2 Timothy 2:11** ]

## HUMILITY

88. Seek advice from every wise person and do not despise any useful counsel.[ **Tobit 4:18** ]

89. . Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, so that he may exalt you in due time.[ **1 Peter 5:6** ]

## CHARITY

90. . If you have many possessions, make your gift from them in proportion; if few, do not be afraid to give according to the little you have. [ **Tobit 4:8** ]

## FORGIVENESS

91. And be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ has forgiven you. [ **Ephesians 4:32** ]

## BRAVERY

92. Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.[ **Philippians 4:6** ]

## ANGER

93. Whoever is slow to anger has great understanding, but one who has a hasty temper exalts folly.[ **Proverbs 14:29** ]

## KINDNESS

94. A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches, and favour is better than silver or gold. [ **proverbs 22:1** ]

## AUTHORITY

95. . Let every person be subject to the governing authorities; for there is no authority except from God, and those authorities that exist have been instituted by God. [ **Romans 13:1** ]

## WEALTH/INVESTMENT

96. The good person brings good things out of a good treasure, and the evil person brings evil things out of an evil treasure. [ **Matthew 12:35** ]

## GENERAL

97. He asked you for life; you gave it to him — length of days for ever and ever. [ **Psalm 21:4** ]
98. For you are the Lord our God, and it is you, O Lord, whom we will praise.[ **Baruch 3:6** ]
99. Therefore be very steadfast to observe and do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, turning aside from it neither to the right nor to the left, [ **Joshua 23:6** ]
